Storage

Store the product in a fresh and dry place. Do not stock the pallets one on top of each other. Protect from freezing or extreme heat. The product warranty is 6 months after its manufacturing date.

Hazards

Avoid dust from damp sanding. Use a mask and safety goggles. Dust resulting from sanding may irritate eyes, nose or throat. In the event of visual contact, thoroughly wash with water for 15 minutes until all particles are removed. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Preparation

Mix contents uniformly without adding water for covering fasteners and corner beads. For taping and finishing joints, thin as necessary by adding clean water especially for use in mechanical tools. Do not add more that 2% (by weight of product) of water because it may cause cracking and bonding problems. Re-mix uniformly after thinning. Do not mix with other products.

This product is manufactured to meet requirements established in ASTM-C475.

Composition

The compound is made of vinyl adhesives and other additives: it can be applied directly from the packaging, manually or with mechanical equipment, and meets the ASTM C-475 Standard in accordance to the ASTM C-474 Standard procedures. For your safety, Panel Rey® products do not contain asbestos.

Second and Third Coat

When the compound is completely dry, approximately 8 hours later, apply a second coat with a 10" taping knife using Finish Pro from Panel Rey then smooth the surface. Repeat the same process for the third coat with a 12" taping knife. Screw heads, fasteners and accessories must be cover with three coats of compound. For more information check GA-236 manual.

Finishing

At the end of the third coat, the joint treatment should be 12" width. After the last coat has dried, lightly sand the joint and the covered accessories, leaving the wall ready for the final finish. All accessories should be covered with three layers of compound. Before applying, make sure that these are clean and dry to avoid product detachment.
