Storage

Preparation

Mix contents uniformly without adding water for covering fasteners and corner bead. For taping and finishing joints, thin as neccessary by adding clean water especially for use in mechanicals tools. Do not add more that 2% (by weight of product) of water because it may cause cracking and bonding problems. Re-mix uniformly after thinning. Do not mix with other products. This product is manufactured to meet requirements established in ASTM-C475.

Composition

The compound is made of vinyl adhesives and other additives: it can be applied directly from the packaging, manually or with mechanical equipment, and meets the ASTM C-475 Standard in accordance to the ASTM C-474 Standard procedures. For your safety, Panel Rey® products do not contain asbestos.

General Application

COVERING JOINTS AND APPLYING THE FIRST LAYER

Apply Ultima Plus compound over joints with a 6" knife. Inmediately put joint tape over covered area use the same knife to remove any excess of compound over the joint tape. Apply first layer of compound over the tape with an 8" knife.

APPLYING THE SECOND AND THIRD LAYER

After the first layer of Ultima Plus compound is completely dry apply a second layer with the 10" knife over the tape, and once dried, proceed with a third layer of Ultima Light using the 12" knife.

FINISH

The total width of the joint treatment should be not less that 12". After the third layer is completely dry, softly sand over joints, removing any excess of dry compound and leaving a dust-free suface ready for the final finishing. Nails, screw heads, corner beads, archways and any other accessories must be treated as well three layers of Ultima Plus compound.
